Topic: Transformation

- The children created a story map detailing what happened on the road to Emmaus: Luke 24:13-35.

Vocabulary: peace, transformation, attributes, change, gift, Holy Spirit.

English

Maths

Topic: Geometry

Science

Topic: Forces and Space: unbalanced forces

- They have explored continuous line drawing.

Key vocabulary: Architecture, Form, Structure, Materials, Balance, Scale, Interior, Exterior, Context, Location
