Year 1 Update

We have enjoyed welcoming the children into Key Stage 1 this week. Children have settled well into new routines and it has been lovely getting to know them. Please remind children to line up in the line on the playground at 08:50am when the bell rings. The children can then walk into school in the line with their friends independently.

RE

o This week we have been learning about the creation story. Children learnt what was created on each day and drew pictures.

Pre-Teaching:

 Next week, we will continue learning about this next week and will create a display for our classroom.

English

o This week we have been exploring the book 'Jasper's Beanstalk' by Nick Butterworth and Mich Inkpen. Children were able to order pictures for the story and write a short sentence. They were focusing on remembering to use capital letters and full stops.

Pre-teaching:

o Next week, children will be writing instructions for how to grow their own beanstalk.

Maths:

o This week, we have been learning to use prepositional words and phrases including; behind, next to, in front, beside, over and under.

Pre-Teaching:

Next week we will be learning to subitise. This means being able to look at an amount and knowing how many without counting. For example, rolling dice with dot formations and knowing the number. Board games are a very good way to practise this!

Science

o This week we started our new topic, 'Seasonal changes'. Children were thinking about what the weather is like in the different seasons of the year.

Pre-Teaching:

o Next week, children will make weather craft models based on each season.
