English

- We have continued our learning on 'Frog and the Stranger'. We have really focused on using coordinating conjunctions to extend our writing. Conjunctions are great to add extra information to our writing.

Reading

Maths

- This week we have continued our place value topic by looking at odd and even numbers.
- We have also looked at how ten ones become one ten and how one ten is equal to ten ones.
- Next week, we will be exploring the different ways we can make a two digit number.

Vocabulary: tens, ones, digit, numerals, place value, odd, even

Science

- Our Science topic this half term is Living Things and their Habitats.
- We have looked at the different life processes that makes something alive.
- Next week, we will begin exploring different habitats.

Vocabulary: movement, reproduction, sensitivity, growth, respiration, excretion, nutrition
