RE

Topic: Creation and Covenant

• The children continued to learn about Moses' life, focusing this week on the Sinai covenant and the Ten Commandments (Ex 19:3-8, 20:1-17)

Vocabulary: Covenant, creation, Exodus, Old Testament, commandment

Pre-teaching: Next week we will be looking in more detail about covenants that God made with his people. In particular we will be thinking about the covenants God made with Noah, Abraham, Israel and King David. To prepare you may want to recap these stories.

English

Books: The mythical beasts & magical creatures by Stephen Krensky

Usborne The World of unknown monsters

 Children have been continuing to develop their own ideas for a mythical creature they have designed and have made a plan of what to include in their report writing.

SPaG: Children have been learning about the use of parenthesis using brackets.

Key vocabulary: reports, inform, subordinate clause, subordinating conjunctions, main clause, parenthesis, brackets.

Pre-teaching: next week children will be beginning to write their reports on their mythological creatures.

Maths

Topic: Place value

- Children have been working with 7 digit numbers.
- They have been practising ordering 7 digit numbers.
- They have been learning to add and subtract powers of 10: 10, 100, 100, 10,000.

Key vocabulary: ones, tens, hundreds, thousands, ten thousands, hundred thousands, millions, ascending, descending.

Pre-teaching: next week the children will be rounding numbers.

Science:

Topic: Materials - Mixtures and separation

• Children have been exploring separating mixtures by sieving.

Key vocabulary: mixture, particle, sieve, sieving.

Pre-teaching: Children will be learning about the process of filtering.

Homework

- The children's spelling test will be on Monday.
- All homework will be set on Teams.
