## **Attendance Update**

We are increasingly concerned about families taking holidays during term time, especially towards the end of term or at the beginning of a new term. This is a national issue, and the government rules introduced last August mean stricter fines and procedures for unauthorised absences.

We understand the financial pressures families face, but we've seen a rise in cases where illness is reported for an absence, only for children to later share details of holidays. This puts pupils in a difficult position, makes things very difficult for staff and undermines the trust between home and school.

Most families do follow the government rules, and we're grateful for that. However, we must remind families that we are not able to authorise holidays during term time, and families may be asked produce evidence if an absence is unclear. If we learn a child is on holiday while reported as ill, we must record the absence as unauthorised and report it to County, this can also be carried out retrospectively.

Thank you for your continued support in helping us maintain accurate attendance records.

The whole school attendance has been **96%** from the 4th September until 16th October.

A particular well done all the classes who received 97% attendance rate at this time.
