Year 4 Update

RE

 This week the children have explored the testing of Abraham and his faith in God. We retold the story of Abraham and Isaac.

Pre-Teaching:

 Next week we will be focusing on the Catholic Social Teaching theme of 'Care of Creation'. We will also reflect on the Faith, Hope and Love shown in Joseph's life.

English
