

Year 2 Update 7.11.2025

RE

- In R.E this week we have begun our new topic of Prophecy and Promise.
- We have looked at the Prophets Zechariah and John the Baptist and recognised why they were important in preparing people for the coming of Jesus.
- Next week, we will be looking at the Annunciation.

Vocabulary: Prophet, Messiah, Zechariah, Elizabeth, Jesus, Angel Gabriel

English

- We have explored poetry this week, we have written two different list poems. One focused on autumn and one based on what we have been doing lately.
- We explored expanded noun phrases and past tense.
- Next week, we will be looking at narrative writing focusing on a book 'Last street on market street'.

Vocabulary: poetry, adjectives, past tense, expanded noun phrases.

Maths

- This week we have continued our topic of Addition and Subtraction by using our number bonds to add and subtract two two-digit numbers.
- The children have recapped their number bonds to 10 and 100 and used these to make 100 in a variety of ways using addition and subtraction.
- Next week, we will be focusing on doubles and near doubles and finding the nearest 10.

Vocabulary: digit, addend, equals, subtrahend, minuend, difference, number bond.

Science

- Our Science topic this half term is Microhabitats.
- The children have discovered what a microhabitat is and have created a classification key to group different minibeasts.
- Next week, we will be creating a wormery to observe over time.

Vocabulary: Microhabitat, minibeast, classification, invertebrate, grouping.
