English

Key vocabulary: non-chronological, heading, sub-heading, caption, label, diagram

Maths

- Children have been building fluency with mental subtraction

Key Vocabulary: subtraction, minuend, subtrahend, difference, not commutative

Coming up next week: written methods for addition

Science

- In science this week, we have started our new topic called Forces and Magnets. This week we learnt about the key vocabulary linked to this topic and completed the pre-assessment.

Key Vocabulary: force, push, pull, friction, surface, magnet, magnetism, North Pole and South Pole
