Year 5 update

R.E

Topic: Prophecy and Promise

- Children have been learning about King David, and why he was important in the history of God's people.
- Children watched a recording of a theatre production about King David's life.

Key vocabulary: prophet, judge, anointed, humility, pride.

Pre-teaching: How many characters can your child name from the Old Testament?

English

Book: Cloud Tea Monkeys

Purpose: Writing to entertain

- Children have been focusing on how dialogue is punctuated.
 - Place inverted commas at the beginning and end of the words being spoken.
 - Begin spoken words with a capital letter.
 - Use the correct punctuation between the direct speech and the reporting clause.
 - Start a new line for a new speaker.

Pre-teaching: next week the children are completing their final piece of writing for this topic. They will be writing a description of a scene based on the focus book. Prior to the lesson you might want to talk to your child about some of the features of a description they have been learning about, e.g dialogue, sensory language, figurative language, expanded noun phrases, adverbials.

Maths

- Children have recapped their learning of factors and prime numbers.
- Children have been identifying composite numbers (numbers that have more than two factors)

Children have been sorting numbers using venn diagrams.

Key vocabulary: factors, prime numbers, square numbers, composite numbers.

Science

Topic

Materials: properties and changes

• Children have been exploring the transparency and uses of various materials using a light meter app.

Key vocabulary: transparent, translucent, opaque, light meter, lux, light intensity.

Pre-teaching: Next weeks' lesson is focusing on conductivity. You might like to question your child on whether they think some household objects conduct electricity.

E-safety

 Year 5 learned how to recognise and stay safe from junk mail and spam emails, discussing how to spot suspicious messages and what to do if they receive one.

Key vocabulary: email, junk mail, spam, scam, inbox, phishing, link, personal information
