This week the children received their monitor badges during a special KS2 assembly. We are very proud of how seriously the Year 6 children have been taken their responsibilities and many teachers have commented on the commitment they have shown to their roles so far. Religious Education

- Padua started the new RE topic, 'Prophecy and Promise' and completed biographies of some key female figures from the Old Testament.
- Lisbon looked at the meaning of the Nicene Creed and how it links to both John's Gospel and the story of creation in Genesis.

Vocabulary: begotten, consubstantial, Messiah, trust, vocation, women religious

Mathematics

- Lisbon have been looking at prime numbers, factors, multiples and square numbers.
- Padua have been revising the formal method of long multiplication.

Vocabulary: prime, factor multiply, carry, exchange, columns, magic zero

Pre-learning

Next week Padua will be working on the area of shapes and Lisbon will be revising long multiplication.

My Maths

- We have signed up to the online maths programme, 'My Maths' which is a useful homework resource.

- Each homework task comes with a video and step-by-step guide to explain the activity.
- We have set several tasks which will help the children consolidate what they have already learnt in school.
- The children should ideally complete one activity a week but we appreciate that there will be some weeks where the children have other commitments.
- The deadline for completion of this work will be December 19th.

English

- This week we have started our work based on the book 'Planetarium'. We have looked at taking notes using bullet points to summarise the key information about the solar system.
- We have also looked at the features of non-chronological reports.
- Padua started to plan their own non-chronological report about the moon Pandora from the Avatar universe.

Vocabulary: bullet points, key information, note-taking

Pre- learning

- Next week both classes will continue to work on their non-chronological reports.
