

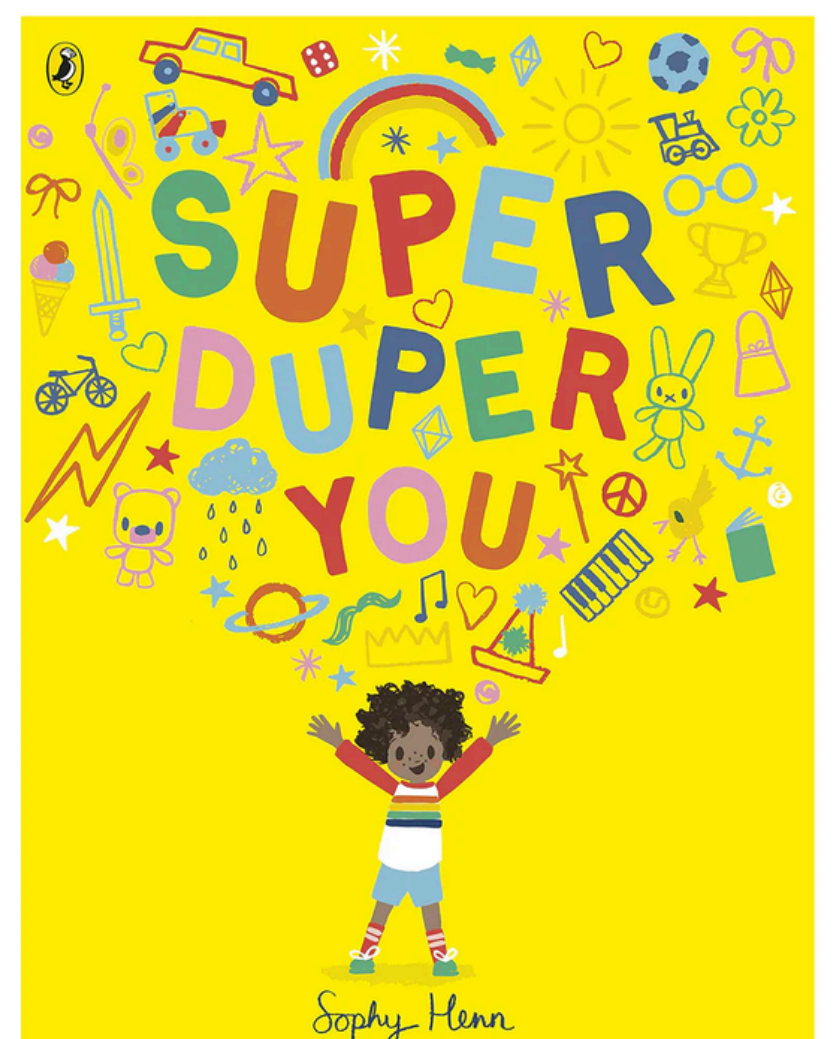


# Reception Poppies w/c 15th September- Super Duper You

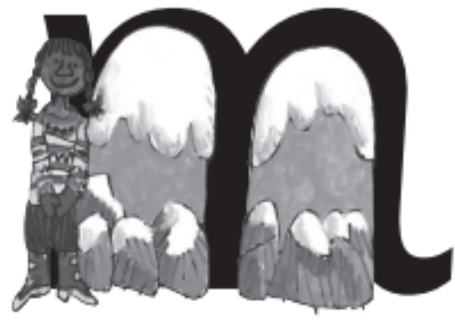












## Phonics

If you are practising with your child at home please make sure you are practising the correct letter formations.

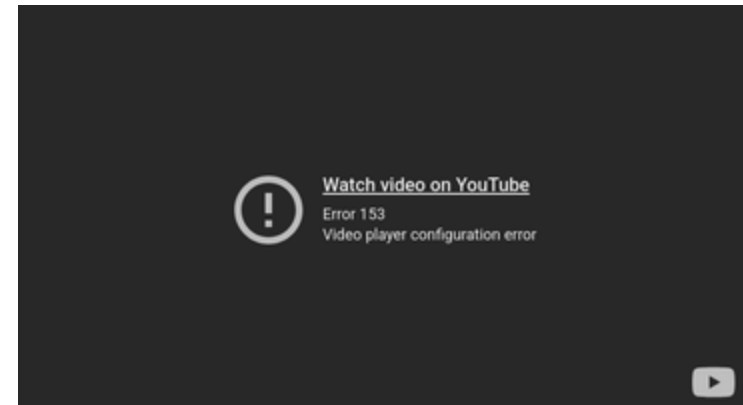
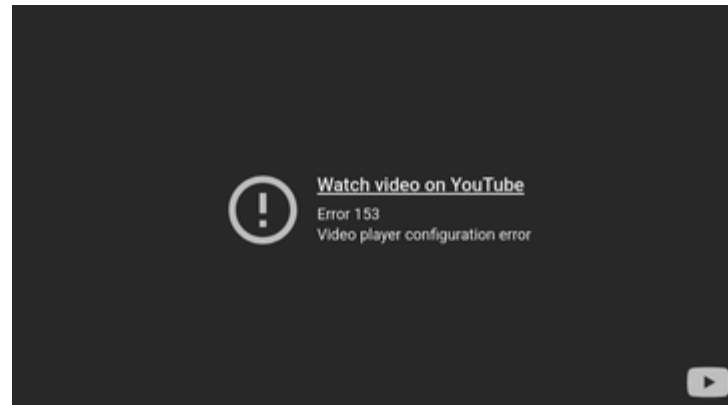
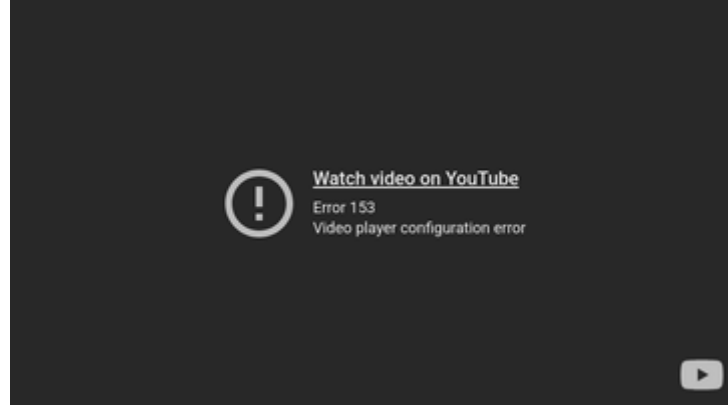
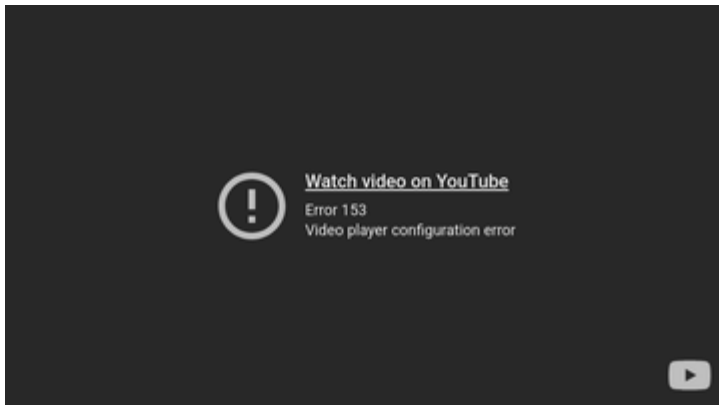
m - Maisie, mountain, mountain

s - slither down the snake

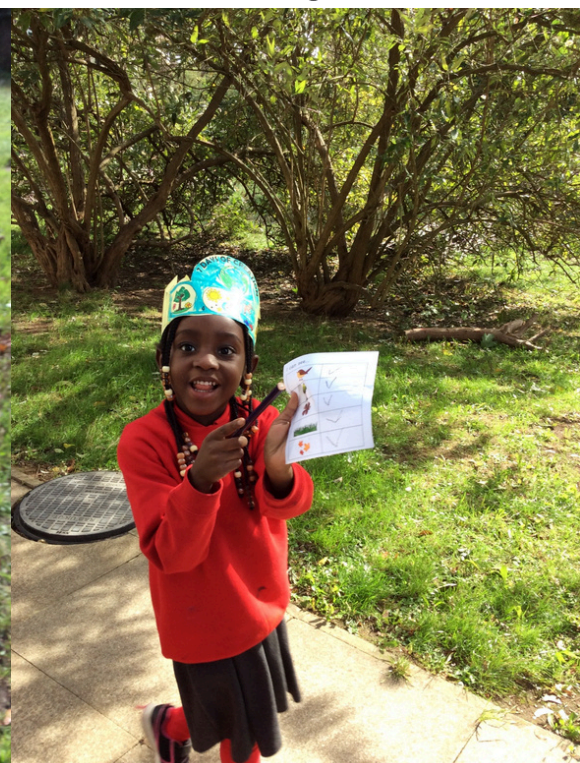
a - around the apple and down the leaf

d - round his bottom, up his tall neck, down to his feet

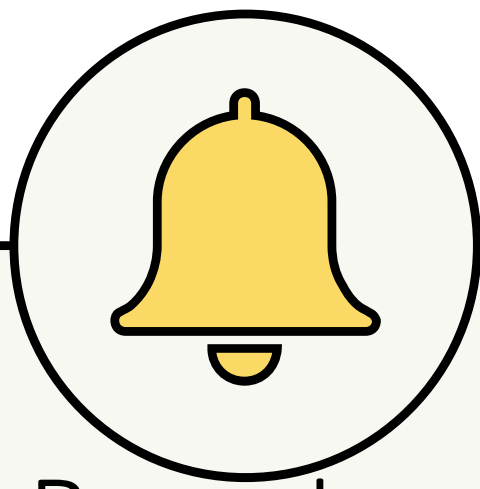
This is a link to some You Tube videos which show the letter formation and caption for each letter. Please only practise the ones we have covered in school so far.

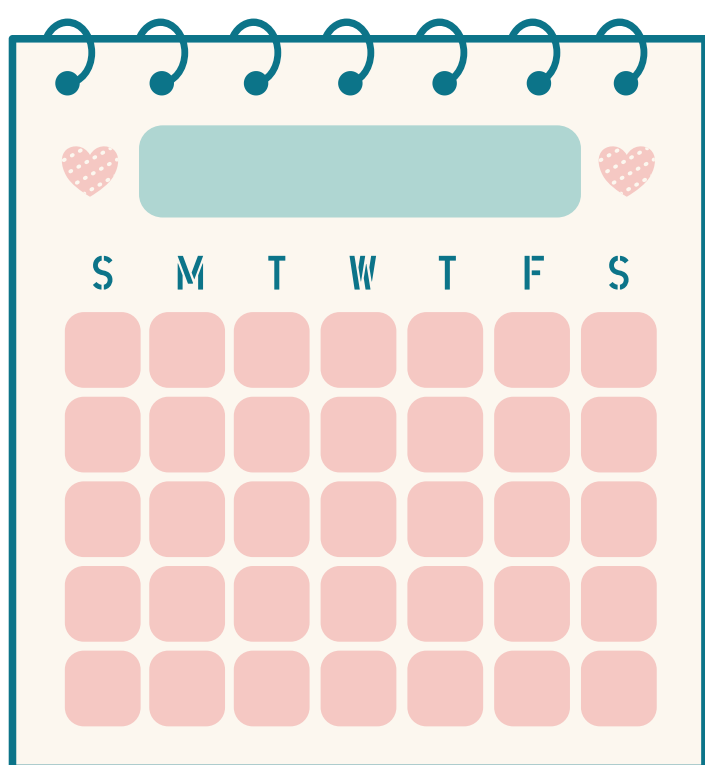






Reminder:

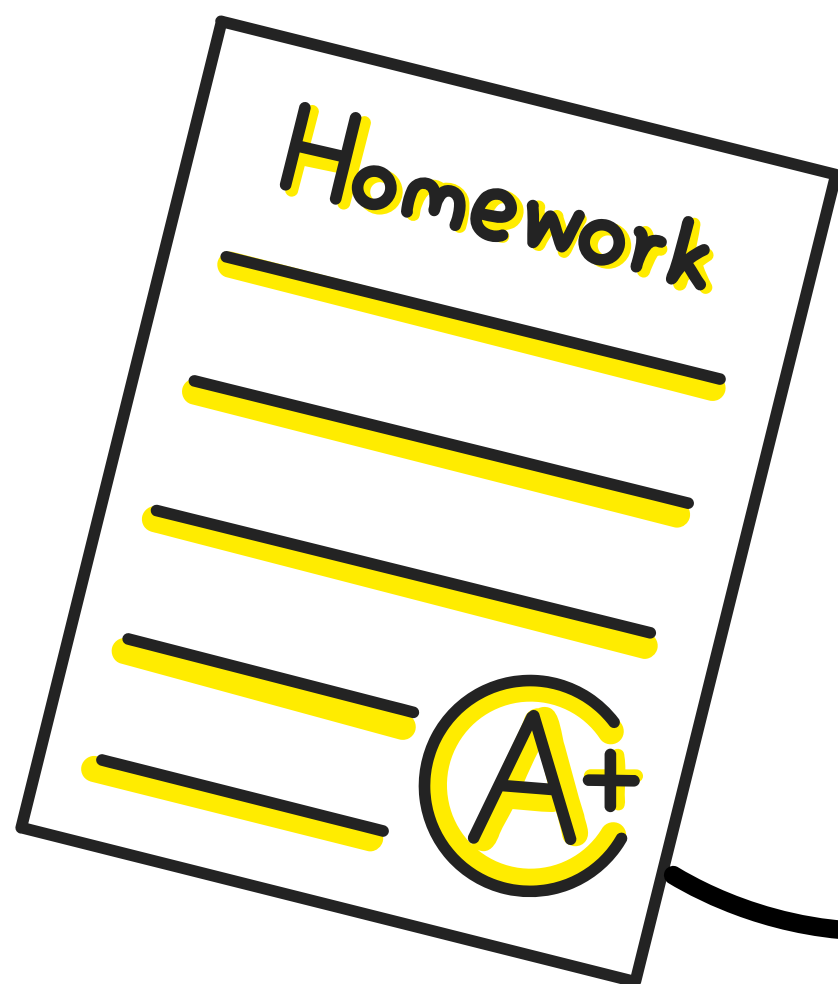
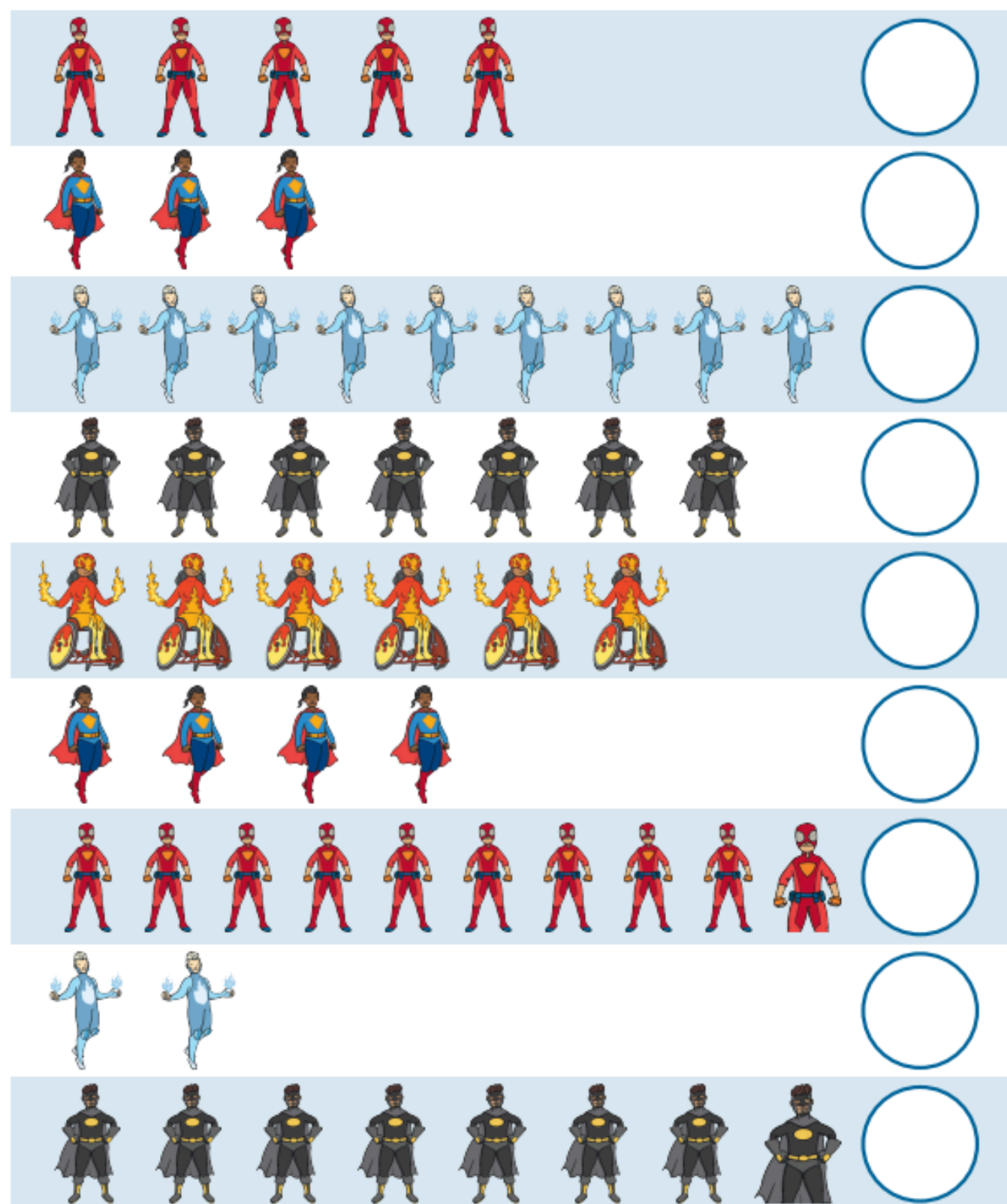
