


Reception Poppies w/c 29th September-The Gingerbread Man




Phonics









This week in phonics we have looked at the sounds: p, g and o.


The captions for this weeks letters are:

We will add the links to the videos to help with letter formation to Teams if you would like to practise with your child at home.


















National Poetry Day
