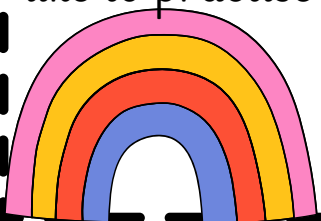

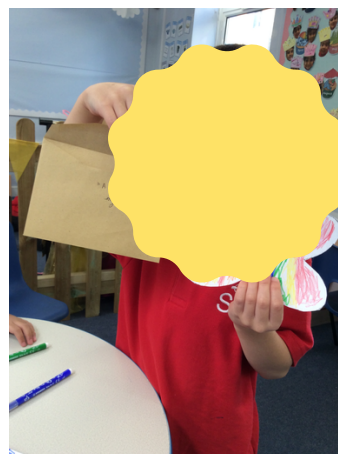
We will add the links to the videos to help with letter formation to Teams if you would like to practise with your child at home.
