They cannot wait to share their production with you all next week. We are very proud of each and everyone of them.



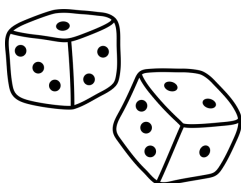

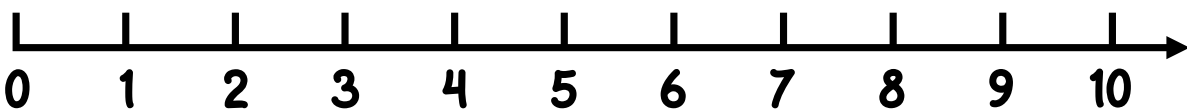
We have looked at descriptive language and how we could describe woodland creatures.

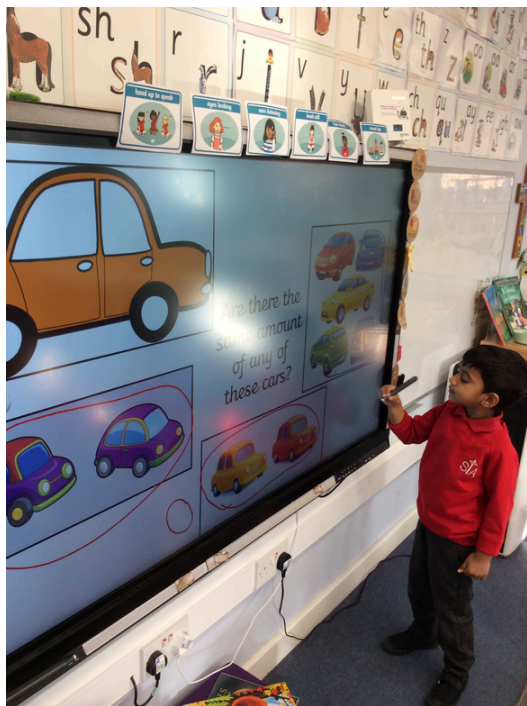


RE in Lilies Class this week..

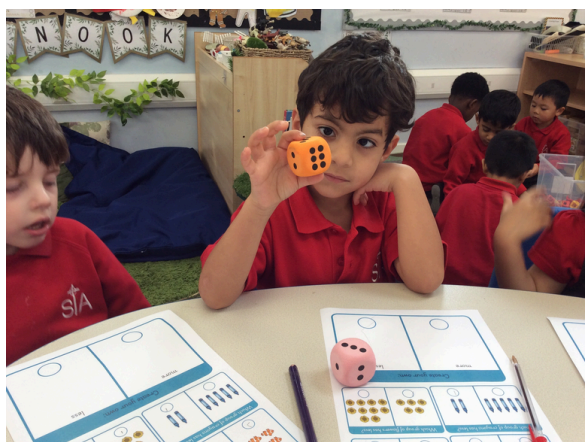

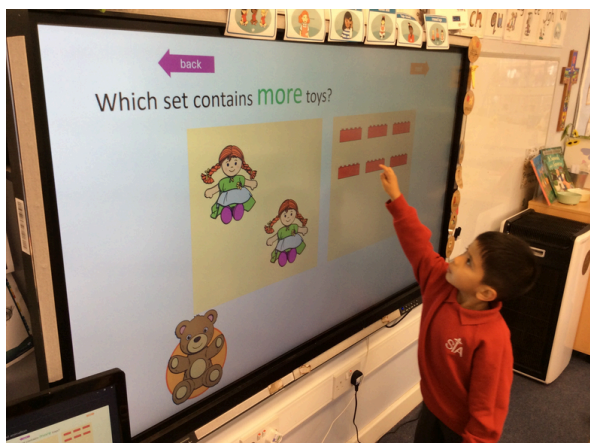

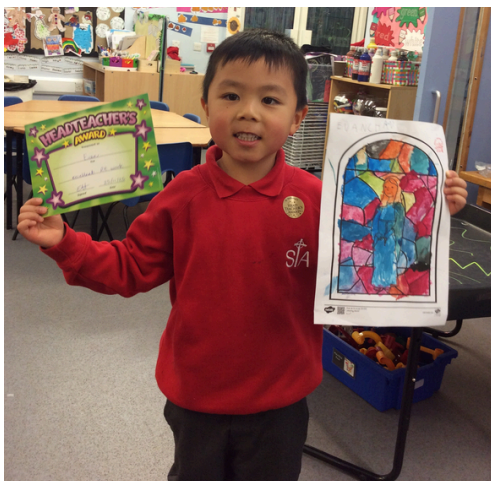
