## Attendance Update

The whole school attendance has been **95%** from **1st September 2025** until **16<sup>th</sup> January 2026**. If your child is absent from school, please telephone/email each day to keep the school office informed. Please remember we are unable to authorise any absence for holidays/trips/visits/celebrations. Recently County have issued fines to families where children have had 10 sessions of unauthorised absence. One day of school is equal to 2 sessions. Absences directly before or after a school holiday cannot be authorised without evidence for the absence. This may include medical evidence if your child is unwell or evidence of delayed flights or circumstances beyond your control.

Children who have below 90% attendance will receive a letter from school as under the guidelines, we have to refer children's attendance figures to the local authority attendance team if they have had more than 15 days illness.
