- This week we have started our new topic 'Galilee to Jerusalem'.
- The children have focused on John the Baptist and thought about Jesus' Baptism.
- Next week, we will be looking at the story of Jesus in the desert.

*Vocabulary: John the Baptist, prophet, repent, sin, baptize.*

### English

**Please can children bring in a postal stamp and their home address on Monday for post card writing next week.**

- We have been reading 'Dragon Post'. We have thought about the different features in written communication such as letters, postcards and emails. We have applied our knowledge to write postcards. Next week, we are going to walk to the post box to post these off!
- Next week, the children will be writing a text message and looking at different ways to communicate.

*Vocabulary: informal, past tense, verb, expanded noun phrase.*

### Maths

- This week we have started our topic on measurement by looking at different methods of measuring height, weight, and capacity.
- Next week we will be classifying data.

*Vocabulary: measurement, capacity, volume, length, centimetre, litre, gram, millilitre.*

### Science

- This week we have begun our new topic focusing on materials.
- The children have classified a range of different materials by their properties.
- Next week we will be thinking about which material is most suitable for a pair of tights.

*Vocabulary: material, property, hard, soft, smooth, rough.*
