Happy New Year! We hope you have all enjoyed a relaxing break over Christmas. Thank you very much for the lovely cards and gifts that member of the Year 4 team received - we appreciate your kindness.

RE

- This week we have celebrated the Epiphany Feast Day. We wrote acrostic poems about the Epiphany. We have also begun our new topic of 'Galilee to Jerusalem'. The children recreated a scene of John the Baptist preaching, and considered what the Jewish people gathered with him would have thought about the coming of the Messiah.

Pre-Teaching:

- Next week, we will be studying Jesus' miracles, including 'Jesus heals Peter's mother-in-law and others' (Matthew 8: 14-17)

English

- This week, Padua compared Starbird to a new text, 'Ziraffe Giraffe'. The children worked hard to use appropriate fronted adverbials when describing various settings.
- This week, Lisbon continued with their newspaper articles.

Pre-teaching:

- Next week, Padua will be using the texts as a basis for their own animal narratives.
- Next week, Lisbon will begin 'Starbird', looking at the structure of events in the story and different settings.

Maths

- Padua have been calculating the perimeter of shapes. They have also calculated perimeter when some of the data is missing. Their My maths homework this week should consolidate their learning.
- Lisbon have been measuring mass this week and also completed some work on pictograms, solving problems by interpreting data.

Pre-Teaching:

- Next week, the children will be exploring place value, including decimals.

Science

- This week we have begun our new topic Electricity and Circuits. We explored how a circuit works and thought about mains and battery powered appliances.

Pre-Teaching:

- Next week, we will be exploring the symbols of components and building circuits.
