Thank you to parents who attended our Maths Information Meeting, the presentation will be available on the Maths area on our website.

### RE

- This week we have looked at the Gospel story of the parable of the lost sheep.
- The children wrote prayers based on what the parable teaches us, thanking Jesus for the message that God loves everyone and everyone is important.
- After half term, we will begin looking at the Easter story.

*Vocabulary: parable, good shepherd, Gospel, disciple, apostle.*

### English

- Wow – We have been blown away by the children's amazing storytelling skills. This week they completed their independent writing assessment based on Rapunzel. It's lovely to see them using expanded noun phrases, conjunctions and past tense verbs in their writing.
- After half term, we will be looking at the features of non-fiction writing. Our book will be: Big Blue Whale.

*Vocabulary: expanded noun phrases, adjectives, commas and past tense.*

### Maths

- This week we have continued looking at problem solving.
- We have explored the different representations that can help us solve word problems.
- After half term, we will be learning how to tell the time.

*Vocabulary: subtrahend, minuend, addend, sum, total, difference, part, whole.*

### Science

- We have concluded our topic on materials by looking at eco-friendly materials.
- The children have designed an eco-friendly party bag.
- After half term, we will be starting our new topic looking at living things.

### World Book Day

World Book Day is the 5<sup>th</sup> March – this year we ask the children to dress up as a word. Please see the reading newsletter for more information and some pictures of ideas. There is also a competition for children to enter. We would love to see how creative Year 2 are!
