### RE

- This week we have begun our Lenten topic.
- The children have made Lenten promises and discovered how Lent is a time for asking for forgiveness. We thought about the word sorry and made sorry pathways in chalk.
- Next week, we will be looking at the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

*Vocabulary: Lent, forgiveness, reconciliation, fast, pray, sin, give*

### English

- This week we have started our new book of The Big Blue Whale by Nichola Davies.
- We have identified features of non-fiction texts and practiced writing statement sentences.
- Next week, we will be writing expanded noun phrases and using conjunctions.

*Vocabulary: statement, question, command, exclamation, punctuation, comma*

### Maths

- This week we have begun looking at telling the time.
- We have practiced telling the time (o'clock, half past, quarter past, quarter to)
- Next week, we will be continuing telling the time in 5-minute intervals. and applying this knowledge to problem solving.

*Vocabulary: analogue, minute, hour, to, past, interval.*

### Science

- We have begun our new topic of life cycles by looking at the human lifecycle.
- Please continue to bring in photos of your child as a baby/toddler and a current photo.
- Next week, we will be looking at the life cycle of a frog.

*Vocabulary: life cycle, adolescence, adult, elderly*
