### RE

- This week we have looked at reconciliation.
- The children have reflected on the five steps of reconciliation.
- Next week, we will begin looking at the Last Supper.

*Vocabulary: Lent, forgiveness, reconciliation, sacrament, Jerusalem, journey*

### English

- This week we have continued our book of The Big Blue Whale by Nichola Davies.
- We have looked at different types of conjunctions and using expanded noun phrases within our writing.
- Next week, we will begin writing about a chosen animal to form a non-chronological report.

*Vocabulary: statement, question, command, exclamation, punctuation, comma*

### Maths

- This week we have applied our time knowledge to problem solving.
- We have placed different events on a timeline and have been thinking about duration of time.
- Next week, we will begin looking at multiplication and division by doubling and halving.

*Vocabulary: analogue, minute, hour, to, past, interval, duration,*

### Science

- This week we have sequenced the life cycle of a frog.
- Next week, we will be looking at features of the human lifecycle.

*Vocabulary: life cycle, frog, tadpole, frogspawn*
