

Our Trip to Knebworth House

RE

- This week we have focussed on Good Friday.
- The children have considered how the events of Good Friday relate to the sacrament of Reconciliation.
- Next week, we will be exploring the Easter Vigil.

Vocabulary: Lent, forgiveness, reconciliation, betrayal, crucifixion.

English

- This week we have complete termly assessments in Reading, Grammar and Spelling.
- We are proud of how hard the children worked in these.
- Next week, we will be starting our new text 'Julian is a mermaid'. We will be focus on narrative writing.

Vocabulary: comma, caption, non-fiction, research, report, mind map

Maths

- This week we have continued to focus on the 2-, 5- and 10-times tables.
- We have also completed termly assessments in reasoning and arithmetic.
- Next week, we will be linking multiplication and repeated addition.

Vocabulary: times, multiply, skip count, product.

Science

- This week we have researched what different animals needs to survive.
- Next week, we will be looking at hygiene and exercise.

Vocabulary: life cycle, adaptations, diet, survival.
