- The children have been solving word problems based on the 3-, 4- and 8-times tables. This included division word problems. Example below:

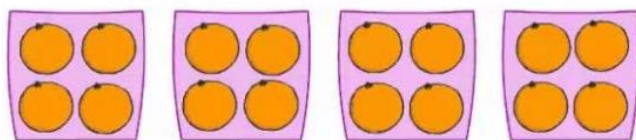
## DIVISION BY SHARING
