Mathematics

- Year 6 Padua revised measures this week and Year 6 Lisbon studied ratio and proportion.
- The children also practiced a wide range of problem-solving questions in preparation for the SATs.

Vocabulary: cm, m, km, g, kg, for every, part of a whole

Pre-learning

- We will continue to revise a variety of topics next week including reflection, translation, measuring and drawing angles.

SATS Preparation

- Over the last couple of weeks, the children have completed the 2018 past SATs papers in Mathematics, Reading and Spelling and Grammar (SPAG) and have started to complete the 2019 past papers.
- We have gone through each of these tests as a whole class and addressed any issues that have arisen while also discussing exam technique to enable the children to gain the most marks they can.
- We will continue to work through past SATs papers over the coming weeks.
