

Year 6 Update – Friday 6th March 2026

This week we celebrated World Book Day, the children looked fantastic in their various 'word' costumes and enjoyed taking part in different book related activities in their classrooms.

Religious Education

- We will be starting our new Lenten topic next week, 'Desert to Garden'.
- During this unit of work the children will be studying some of the last few events of Jesus' life.

Vocabulary: crucifixion, anoint, discourse, Stations of the Cross

Mathematics

- We have continued with our revision this week and the children have completed a complete set of SATs papers.
- We have gone through the questions in detail and have gone over any concepts that the children have found challenging.
- Year 6 Padua have been also looking at ratio and practising these types of sums.
- Year 6 Lisbon have been looking at the features of 3D shapes and used a variety of clues to name them.

Vocabulary: one in every, ratio, faces, edges, vertices

Pre-learning

- We will continue with our revision next week and Padua will look at 3D shapes and Lisbon will be learning about ratio.

English

- This week we have continued with our preparation for SATs and the children completed a grammar and reading comprehension paper.
- We also revisited past perfect, past progressive tense and determiners.
- The children have worked hard with this work and it's pleasing to do see the progress they are making.

Vocabulary: simple past tense, definite articles, quantifiers

Pre-learning

- We will be continuing with more grammar revision next week.
- We will also go through the comprehension paper that the children completed this week.

KAPLA Club Workshop

- This week, the whole school has been participating in a huge construction project provided by KAPLA Club.
- Every class from Nursery to Year 6 was involved in creating an entire city, complete with animals that are made just by identical small cuboid-shaped planks.
- The children learnt different construction techniques to form different shapes and structures.
- The final construction was incredible, and the children should be incredibly proud of their efforts.

Secondary Transition Workshop
