RE

- We celebrated that Jesus has Risen by updating our classroom displays.
- This week we have discussed the ascension.
- The children have retold the events on the ascension.
- Next week, we will look at Pentecost.

Vocabulary: ascension, resurrection, apostle, disciple, Holy Spirit.

English

- This week we have continued to look at Julian is a Mermaid. We have written descriptive sentences and learnt how to use apostrophes for contracted form:
E.g he will – he'll, I am – I'm
- Next week, we will be writing our own stories applying the knowledge that we have learnt in this topic.

Vocabulary: description, adjectives, expanded noun phrases, apostrophes

Maths

- This week we have focused on problem solving using multiplication.
- The children have looked at how the language used in multiplication can help us to solve problems.
- Next week, we will be moving onto division.

Vocabulary: times, multiply, product, multiplier, factor, represent, commutative.

Science

- This week we have begun our new topic of Plant Growth.
- The children are conducting an experiment over the next few weeks looking at the conditions a plant needs to grow (light, water, warmth).
- Next week, we will be looking at seeds and bulbs.

Vocabulary: plant, growth, germination, light, water, warmth, conditions.
