RE

- We have looked at Pentecost.
- The children have written diary entries from the perspective of Peter and reflected on artwork portraying this event.
- Next week, we will look at the conversion of Saul.

Vocabulary: ascension, resurrection, apostle, disciple, Holy Spirit., Pentecost

English

- This week we have continued to look at Julian is a Mermaid.
- The children have written their own stories in present tense based on the structure of Julian is a Mermaid.
- Next week, the children will be exploring poetry and using similes within the poems.

Vocabulary: description, adjectives, expanded noun phrases, apostrophes

Maths

- This week we have focused on dividing numbers by sharing and grouping.
- The children have looked at a variety of methods to help them to divide by 2, 5 and 10.
- Next week, we will be dividing with remainders.

Vocabulary: divide, divisor, dividend, quotient, share, group.

Science

- This week we have explored seeds and bulbs.
- The children cut open bulbs to discover the plant inside, we have continued to monitor the growth of our plants.
- Next week, we will be looking at germination.

Vocabulary: plant, growth, germination, light, water, warmth, conditions.
