### RE

- This week we have looked at the conversion of Saul.
- The children have role played the story and reflected on its importance.
- Next week, we will look at the fruits of the Holy Spirit.

*Vocabulary: apostle, disciple, Holy Spirit., conversion*

### English

- This week we have looked at simile poems. We worked collaboratively to write one about our school. Then we worked independently to write a simile poem about someone special to us.
- Next week, we will be writing our poems up in neat and starting our new text 'How to wash a Woolly Mammoth'.

*Vocabulary: similes, poems, comparing.*

### Maths

- This week we have focused on dividing with remainders.
- The children have thought about how they know a calculation will have a remainder.
- Next week, we will be starting our topic on fractions.

*Vocabulary: divide, divisor, dividend, quotient, share, group, remainder.*

### Science

- This week we have explored germination.
- The children have thought about how seed turns into a plant and have measured their own plants.
- Next week, we will be looking at the effect of light on plant growth.

*Vocabulary: plant, growth, germination, light, water, warmth, conditions.*
