Thursday 14th May 2026	Mathematics Reasoning (Paper 3) - 40 minutes

## English

- We have continued with our grammar revision this week and discussed with the children the importance of being secure with their knowledge of word classes (nouns, adjectives, adverbs, verbs, pronouns, determiners, conjunctions and prepositions) as these form the basis for many of the questions in the SATs test.
- We have also recapped past and present progressive, adverbials and grammatical terms.
- The children can continue to use the Grammar Monster website as a way of revising all the grammar topics they will be tested on in May.

## Mathematics

- We have continued with our revision this week and looked at volume and time among other topics.
- We went through the timetable homework that the children were set last week.
- The children also completed the 2024 past papers in arithmetic and reasoning.

## SATs Breakfast

- The children are invited to come to school at 8:10 am every morning from the 11<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> May for breakfast; this is a chance for them to meet their friends, have some food and hopefully help them feel relaxed and ready for their SATs.
