Wednesday 13th May 2026	Mathematics Arithmetics (Paper 1) - 30 minutes Mathematics Reasoning (Paper 2) - 40 minutes
Thursday 14th May 2026	Mathematics Reasoning (Paper 3) - 40 minutes

It is important that they are in school next week for their tests as they are the only formal assessments they will sit before their GCSEs in Year 11 and therefore the only official data their secondary schools will have about the children's attainment.
