RE

- This week we continued our new topic 'Dialogue and Encounter'. We thought about the thoughts and behaviour of Paul before and after his conversion on the road to Damascus.
- We also began learning about Islam. The children learnt about the importance of the Five Pillars of Islam and what the pillars mean for Muslims in their daily lives.

Pre-Teaching:

- Next week, we will be studying 1 Corinthians 13 and thinking about Paul's teachings about love, the greatest gift.

English

- This week children have been continuing to learn about features of non chronological reports. They also continued to practice apostrophes for possession.

Pre-teaching:

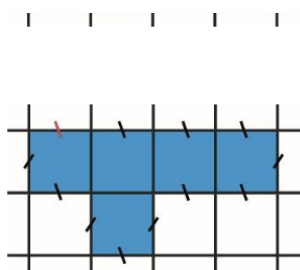
- Next week, children will begin to draft and edit their own non-chronological reports.

- This week, we began working on area. The children were able to count squares to calculate area of rectilinear shapes and began to solve problems involving area.

Pre-Teaching:

What is the perimeter of this shape?

I counted 12 sides of squares around the edge of the shape.
Perimeter = 12cm.

Science

- This week we carried out an experiment on Viscosity. Children recorded their results and presented them in a bar chart.
