RE

- This week we have read the story of the Good Samaritan.
- The children have taken part in a hot seat activity to think about what we can learn from this.
- We have thought about what this story teaches us about knowing that everyone is important and treating others how we wish to be treated.
- Next week, we will be looking at St Anthony in honour of his feast day and how we can be like the good Samaritan in society.

Vocabulary: parable, teaching, Samaritan, love

English

- This week we have continued to look at the story 'Here I Am.'
- The children have finished their recount based on key aspects of the story in the past tense.
- The children then completed a writing assessment based on their trip to the Roald Dahl Museum.
- Next week, we will be editing our writing assessments thinking about the spelling, punctuation, tense and vocabulary choices.

Maths

- This week we have continued our topic on Fractions.
- The children have explored fractions in a real life context.
- Next week, we will be looking at problem solving.
