- In RE this week the children completed a post assessment based on all their learning this half term.

English

- In English this week the children have been using their story map plans of their instructions and have started to write first draft.
- They had to include conjunctions to connect their ideas and use a variety of sentence openers.

Key vocabulary: instruction, draft, conjunction

Coming up after half term: sci-fi fiction narratives

Maths

- To share 2 and 3- digit numbers by ones with regrouping. See example below:

$96 \div 4 = 24$
 Quotient is 24 Regroup 1 ten into 10 ones.

- To link base facts to division. See example below:

3 groups of 4 ones is 12 ones. $3 \times 4 = 12$	3 groups of 4 tens is 12 tens $3 \times 40 = 120$
12 ones shared into 3 equal groups is 4 ones. $12 \div 3 = 4$	12 tens shared into 3 equal groups is 4 tens. $120 \div 3 = 40$

Key vocabulary: regroup, share, quotient, divisor, dividend, base facts

Coming up after half term: Long division

Science

- In Science this week the children complete a post assessment, based on their learning on plants.
