RE

- In RE this week the children continued their learning on Islam.
- They have been learning about their place of worship and what the five pillars are and why they are important to Muslims.

Key vocabulary: Muslim, Islam, Allah, five pillars, Mosque, Qur'an

Coming up next week: The children will be learning about Sikhism.

English

- In this week's English time, the children have been learning about protective behaviours.
- They have been learning about the early warning signs, our bodies tell us when we feel unsafe.
- They have been thinking about what makes them feel calm, safe and relaxed.

Key vocabulary: early warning signs, protective behaviours, safe, calm, relaxed

Maths

- In maths this week this week the children have been revisiting the column method for addition and subtraction.
- They have also been adding money.

Key vocabulary: regroup, exchange, minuend, subtrahend, difference, addend, total, money, pounds, pence

Coming up next week: Subtracting money

- For this week's maths homework, they have been set a task on MyMaths, based on adding and subtracting money.
