RE

- In RE this week the children have been learning about Hinduism.
- They made a fact file about Hinduism including, what Hindus believe and where do Hindus worship?

Key vocabulary: Hinduism, Hindu, Mandir, culture, Braham, religion

Coming up next week: The children will learn about the Hindu festival of Holi

English

- In English this week the children have been editing their own kennings, where they have now written their final version of this.

Key vocabulary: poetry, kenning, edit, draft

Coming up next week: To create a persuasive poster.

Maths

- In Maths this week, the children have been exploring tenths as a decimal. See example below:

Decimals are a way of representing numbers that are not whole. When 1 is divided into 10 equal parts, they are called tenths. Tenths can be represented as decimals:

$$\text{One tenth} = \frac{1}{10} = 0.1$$

Key vocabulary: tenth, decimal, fraction, place value

Coming up next week: To compare and order decimal numbers.

Science

- In Science this week the children completed a post topic assessment.

- For this weeks Maths homework, the children have been set a task on MyMaths.
